VOLUNTEER COMMITMENTS SKI SEASON 2022/2023



Volunteer opportunities give each family a chance to work off their volunteer days, add value to the team, and ultimately save each family money by not having to hire out.

Each MRT family commits to volunteer days. The requirement is 2 volunteer days for 1-day programs and 4 volunteer days for all other programs. For families who choose not to or cannot complete their volunteer commitment, there will be a \$100 fee per volunteer day.

Every volunteer needs to complete a volunteer liability release.





LNumber of Volunteers Needed: (100)/15-20 per event

Commitment: Initial committee kickoff meeting in November., committing to work at least one event which will include one pre-event meeting (1 hour) and the day of work (usually 6 hours)

Description: This committee helps manage MRT-hosted ski events including races, ski-cross, big mountain competitions, etc. Successfully hosting a race/event requires many volunteers and staff. When we host successful events, we have more opportunities to host in the future allowing more 'home' events which is a huge benefit to our athletes. All of the roles and jobs can be taught! With this committee, you will have the opportunity to work in one or several of these roles depending on your interest. volunteer Coordinator







Number of Volunteers Needed: 10+

Description: This committee is responsible for helping to plan and execute MRT social events throughout the season. This includes a holiday party (Dec), an end-of-season BBQ (March), and an Annual Banquet (June).

Commitment: Initial kick-off meeting (Nov.), pre-event planning meetings, day of the event (max 2-3 events per season)

UNIFORMS

Number of Volunteers Needed: 5 reserved for one U10 family, one U12 family, one U14/16 family, and 2 Big Mountain families

Description: This committee will be in charge of all aspects of uniform ordering, sales, Inventory, delivery, and upkeep. This includes selling at the fall BBQ, uniform delivery/ sales at the mountain, and yearly washing of all the coach's uniforms.

Commitment: Initial kick-off meeting (Oct), selling at events, select training weekend in December to manage uniform delivery
